Community COVID-19 Vaccination Information

Please know that every effort is being made to vaccinate as many people as possible. However, as is the case almost everywhere, vaccine deliveries have been inconsistent and unreliable.

Currently, the hospital has not received vaccine for distribution to the public nor do we know when vaccine will arrive. Unfortunately, it may be several months before all members of the general public have access to a COVID-19 vaccine. The state determines the prioritization for vaccination and appointment schedules. As vaccine becomes available, you will be able to register for an appointment. An online electronic scheduling system is currently in development and will be in place soon.

If you qualify for Phase 1A, as described on the PA Department of Health website, please email covidvaccine@brmc.com. An appointment will be required and no walk-ins will be permitted.

- **Please do not call** the county health department, the BRMC main number or any other hospital department for vaccine scheduling as they do not have information on vaccinations.
